


## The Belonging Collection

*The Belonging Collection* is a kit for secondary school teachers. The DVD-ROM, "Choosing Our Future: Jean <u>Vanier</u> in Conversation with Secondary School Students," has several short video clips and questions to stimulate student reflection and in-class discussion on the kind of society they want to help build and the elements that go into such a society. It is suitable for <u>Civics</u>, <u>Social Justice</u>, and <u>Guidance</u> or <u>Leadership</u> programs.

The second main component of the kit is the <u>PlayFair Teams</u> material. It is an 8-week extra-curricular club that creates an inclusive student community around the creation and presentation of a short drama or other group project.

The third component of the kit is the 65 page booklet "Equity, Social Justice, Disability and Secondary Schools: What Regular Subject Teachers Can Do" by Gary Bunch, Rima Al-Salah, and Jack Pearpoint. It contains many useful suggestions for teachers and also has pages on the <u>Circle of Friends</u> and on the planning tools, <u>MAPs</u> and <u>PATH</u>.
